The need to work with an incremental perspective




II) The E-democracy program: characteristics and challenges




Challenges

III) Bill of Rights of the Internet: characteristics and challenges

- ▶ Was an initiative from the Brazilian Ministry of Justice, in partnership with the Center for Technology and Society of the Getulio Vargas Foundation (CTS/FGV), to develop a collaborative process in which all the actors from Brazilian society could identify together the rights and responsibilities that should guide the use of the Internet in Brazil.
- ▶ The process, which resulted in a Bill of Law, is an example of the importance and the great potential of multistakeholder involvement on policy-making.

- ▶ The broader process of participatory law making in Brasil
- ▶ 340.000 digital signatures;
- Hundreds of Thousands of People Monitoring the process day-by-day
- More than 200.000 tweets in the last week





A Bill of Rights for the Internet: Brazil Leads the Way

Late yesterday, Brazil's House of Representatives passed the Marco Civil, a bill aimed at guaranteeing civil rights in the use of the Internet in Brazil. Specifically, it aims to protect privacy rights, net neutrality, safeharbors for internet service providers and online service providers, open government, and setting forth that access to the internet is a requisite to the exercise for civic rights.

The drafting of the Civil Marco Internet in Brazil began in 2009 through a collaborative effort between the Office of Legislative Affairs of the Ministry of Justice, in partnership with the School of Law of the Rio de Janeiro at the Getulio Vargas. Citizen feedback on this bill (between November 2009 and June 2010) was received through social media by more than 2000 contributions of internet users across the country. 






Conclusions: some challenges

- Very "elitist" approach => it is not easy to approximate with common citizens
- It is not easy to attract MPs and their staff to these projects.
- Very "technique" approach => Open Government is not a competition among staff and hackers, but a way to make parliament open to the public opinion ("common citizens")
- In sum: to combine participatory and representative process is not an easy task but there have been improvements and I'm optimistic regarding the results of these projects.
