"In summary, the new PSI Directive **does not seem to take the bold steps** the open data movement has been clamoring for over the past five years. At the same time, **real progress has been made**. [...] But the new PSI Directive will not serve as a tool for citizens aiming for more openness by default and by design. Even with the new redress mechanisms, getting your rights acknowledged and acted upon will remain a long and arduous path as before."

#### recommendations of the study on the report

- 1. Authenticity: the ability to prove the provenance of Parliamentary information;
- 2. Integrity: the ability to ascertain that Parliamentary information has not been changed in the meantime;
- 3. Irrefutability: the ability to use a Parliamentary record as irrefutable proof;
- 4. Transparency: the ability to detect and analyses changes in the Parliamentary record's contents;
- 5. Availability: the availability and accessibility of a document;
- 6. Flexibility: the extent to which technology can be adapted to future requirements and can avoid obsolescence;
- 7. Confidentiality: the extent to which Parliamentary records can be kept confidential if warranted.






