A brief introduction to the Senate

- High Chamber of the French Parliament
- 348 Senators elected through indirect universal suffrage for 6 years
- 1200 civil servants
- 950 parliamentary aides

Information Systems Department

- 35 civil servants, including :
 - 6 systems administrators
 - 1 database administrator
 - 1 information security officer
 - 18 software developers
- 2 development teams :
 - Administrative data processing
 - Document processing



Document processing team

- Develop software used for the law making and government control processes :
 - Publication of reports
 - Verbatim reports
 - Summary reports
 - Discussion of texts in commissions
 - Discussion of texts in plenary sessions
 - Voting system
 - Videos management
 - Questions to the government
 - ...



Document processing team

- Most softwares are developed and maintained in-house
- Most tools are Free or Open Source : specific processes call for custom software
- Structured data, except some reports



Document processing team

- Pioneered the administrative web :
 - 06/12/1995 : first web site
 - 10/06/1996 : verbatim report available online
 - 10/01/1997 : Law making reports online
 - 03/1997 : first forum by OPECST
 - 12/1999 : forum of M. Pierre Laffitte on a FLOSS law proposal
 - 01/2004 : accessible version
 - 10/2009 : Video-on-Demand
 - 11/2010 : mobile version
 - 12/2013 : tablets and smartphones « application »
- Web site nominated for e-democracy trophy in 2010

Open Data Chronology

- <http://data.senat.fr>
- 2011/09 : first experiment during the elections
- 2012/10 : creation of an Open Data Workgroup in the administration :
 - Key principle : grant access in a structured form to all public data related to law making and government control
 - Exhaustive inventory of structured data available
 - Validation and documentation table by table, column by column
- 2013/06/26 : the Questeurs authorizes the launch of data.senat.fr

Open Data Chronology

- 2013/10/25 : « DOSLEG » : database of legislative files (15 Mb)
- 2013/11/26 : « Questions » database (200 Mb)
- 2013/12/23 : « AMELI » (AMEndements en Ligne), amendments database, including texts (43 Mb)
- 2014/02/05 : « Comptes rendus » : reports database (20 Mb)

Technical aspects

- Two kinds of exports :
 - Relational database dumps (PostgreSQL 8.4), for experts
 - CSV files, for everyone
- DB exports are performed in three steps :
 - Copy from Oracle to PostgreSQL using ora2pg
 - SQL filtering (delete, update, alter,...)
 - pg_dump



- Easier access to amendments and texts during a sitting : « En Séance » (~In sitting)








Objectives of « En Séance »
